PROVISION

On the publication of articles in the journal «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology»

Chapter 1. General provision

1.1. These provision defines the rules of preparation for the publication of scientific articles in the journal "Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology", registered with the Information Committee of the Ministry of Information and Social Development of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Certificate of re-registration of periodicals, news agencies and online publications № KZ60VPY00096434 dated 09.07.2024.

1.2. Position Developed in accordance with the requirements for scientific publications to include them in the list of publications recommended for the publication of scientific results, approved by Order No. 20 dated January 12, 2016; on the basis of the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Scientific and Technological Policy" dated July 1, 2024 No. 103-VIII.

1.3. This Regulation uses the following abbreviation:

- Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University – Kyzylorda University named after Korkyt Ata.
- MRNTI – international rubricator of scientific and technical information
- GRNTI – Code of State Categories Scientific and Technical Information
- DOI – Digital Object Identifier.

Chapter 2. Editorial politics and direction of the journal

2.1. Journal «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology» is published 4 times a year and contains information on scientific works of domestic and foreign scientists and materials of scientific conferences, scientific and methodological articles, scientific creativity of young people, information about the life of the university, meeting the requirements for publications in the relevant area.

The main direction of the journal «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology»:

1. Basic and applied research in the field of "Pedagogy and Psychology";
2. "Pedagogy and Psychology" education.

2.2. Tasks of the Editorial politics of “Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology”:

- contribute to improving the quality of scientific research, identifying scientific potential for the implementation of advanced scientific achievements;
- provide scientists and young researchers with the opportunity to publish the results of their research;
- draw attention to the most relevant and promising areas of psychological and pedagogical science;
- ensure collaboration and attract leading domestic and foreign scientists to publications, establish an exchange of opinions between researchers;

Establish and strictly observe the relationships of all parties (editors, authors, reviewers) based on compliance with the requirements for publication ethics;

2.3. The authors are responsible for the factual materials presented in the articles.

2.4. Materials that received a negative assessment based on the results of review and rejected by the journal are not published and are not returned to the authors. The editors do not store rejected materials.

Chapter 3. Ethics requirements for publication in the journal

3.1. All parties involved in the process of preparing materials for publication in the journal - authors, expert commission, reviewers, editorial board members - should follow the following requirements for publication ethics.

The editorial board of the journal takes into account the best practices of reputable international journals when analyzing articles. In order to ensure the high quality of scientific publications, the editorial board is working to prevent the use of plagiarism when publishing articles, the use of incorrect data, the provision of unfounded information, etc. The editorial board, as well as persons involved in the publishing work, must comply with the rules and standards of ethics adopted by the international community, and take all necessary measures to prevent such actions. The editors will never support illegal actions (plagiarism, manipulation, distortion) and will make every effort to ensure that such actions are not allowed.

3.2. The Editor-in-Chief may consult with members of the editorial board and reviewers when making a decision, who shall be guided by the following rules:

- do not disclose information about the submitted manuscript to anyone except the author, reviewers, potential reviewers, other editorial consultants and, if necessary, the publisher;
- do not discriminate in the evaluation of the authors' submissions;
- not to disclose without necessity information about the materials accepted from authors, except authors, reviewers;
- take reasonable measures to identify and prevent the publication of articles in which the research has been improperly conducted, discourage such violations or knowingly permit such violations;
- consider facts or allegations of improper research behaviour;
- be prepared to publish corrections, clarifications, rebuttals and apologies where necessary.

3.3. In the publishing process authors are guided by the following rules:

- to work in full compliance with current legal requirements regarding libel, copyright, legality and plagiarism;
- to provide reliable results of the work done on the original study and an objective discussion of its significance. Contain enough content to ensure a review of the work. False or deliberate erroneous statements may cause material to be rejected or a published article to be refuted;
- Submission of a manuscript simultaneously to another publication is not permitted. The author must not submit to the magazine an article previously published in other publications;

- guarantee the complete originality of the submitted material.

3.4. In the case of using works or statements of other authors, appropriate bibliographic references or excerpts are provided, avoid plagiarism in any form. The article must have at least 80% uniqueness of the text for publications.

3.5. The article is not considered plagiarism, provided that the author(s) refer to their own research work and the citation level of their scientific work does not exceed 20%.

- If elements of the material have previously been published in another article, including in a journal, the author is obliged to cite the most previous research;
- authors are recommended to observe the degree of self-citation within 0-10% .
- the number of authors of the article should not exceed 5 people;
- disclose in their works information about funding, as well as the presence of third-party interests that may be perceived as having influenced the results or interpretation of their manuscript.

- informing the responsible editors in the scientific areas of the journal about a significant error or inaccuracy in the work and ensuring constant contact with the editors of the journal to remove or correct the article.

- articles of members of the editorial board should not exceed 1 article in each issue;

3.6. The number of articles by one author in each issue of the journal should not exceed 2 (one) articles written separately and / or jointly.

Chapter 4. Review of scientific articles submitted to the editorial board of the journal and issuing an opinion (editors), reviewing

4.1. Review of scientific articles and review of manuscripts of scientific articles for publication in the journal "Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology" is carried out in order to maintain a high scientific and theoretical level of publication and selection of the most significant and relevant (promising) scientific works.

4.2. The Editors has the right to reject the materials and require the author(s) to bring them in accordance with the requirements for scientific articles.

4.3. In order to ensure the quality of published materials and copyright compliance, all received materials are checked for the presence of borrowings. The

program is checked by the responsible employee of the university - the "root administrator of the system", and only after that the article is sent for review.

4.4. Authors submitting their articles for publication in the journal "Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology", thereby express their consent to the publication of the article, to the placement of the meta-data of the article (title, Full name authors and their place of affiliation, annotations, keywords, bibliographic list) in open access on the journal's website on the Internet, to transfer the text of the article (including references, bibliographic information, etc.) to persons and organizations to whom the provision of this information is mandatory, or to other persons in order to ensure the possibility of quoting the publication and increase the citation index of authors and the journal, as well as confirm that the submitted articles have not been published in other journals and have not been submitted for publication to other journals.

4.5. The editorial board, under the direction of the editor-in-chief, checks the articles submitted to the editorial board, their compliance with the scientific direction and makes a decision on accepting or rejecting the article.

4.6. The responsible secretary checks accepted articles in the Antiplagiat program after verifying their compliance with the requirements specified in the technical design according to the instructions for authors. (The Antiplagiat verification requirement is fully described in the Rules for Using the Antiplagiat System.) An article whose authenticity exceeds 80% is sent for review. The originality of the text must be at least 80%, otherwise the article is not recognized as unique and is not subject to publication in the journal.

4.7. An expert opinion (for scientists whose scientific orientation corresponds to the content of the article) is issued by any scientist who is part of an approved expert commission. The expert opinion is a protocol (Appendix 1) and the opinion of a member of the expert commission, written and signed in any form and certified by the scientific secretary of the organization (Appendix 2).

4.8. The review procedure is carried out through an online system for submitting and reviewing articles through a "blind review" by a separate electronic site.

4.9. Reviewers are guided by the following rules:

- work in full compliance with the editorial policy of the journal, taking into account current legal requirements regarding libel, copyright, legality and plagiarism;
 - not to use unpublished materials obtained from submitted manuscripts in personal research without the written consent of the author;
 - comply with the review deadlines agreed with the responsible editors;
 - notify the responsible editors and exclude themselves from the review process, who feel incompetent to review the research presented in the manuscript, or who believe that it will be impossible to review the manuscript as soon as possible;
 - to treat any material received for review as a confidential document, not to disclose its content and not to discuss it with any persons other than responsible editors;
 - to give an objective assessment of the materials submitted for review.
- Reviewers should express their opinion clearly and argumentatively.



- to draw the attention of the members of the editorial board, the responsible editors of the series to any significant similarities or coincidences between the manuscript in question and any other published work.

4.10. The review procedure includes the following stages:

1. The article is sent for review to a doctor of sciences, candidate of sciences or PhD, whose scientific specialization is closest to the subject of the scientific article.

2. The terms of reviewing the article may vary depending on the specific situation, but no more than 4 working weeks.

3. The reviewer may not be the author or co-author of the reviewed work, as well as scientific supervisors of applicants for an academic degree, PhD degree and employees of the department in which the author works. Reviews are discussed by the editorial board and serve as the basis for acceptance or rejection of manuscripts.

4. The review should objectively evaluate the scientific article and contain a comprehensive analysis of its scientific and methodological advantages and disadvantages. The review is compiled according to the standard form proposed by the editorial board (Appendix 1, table on the website).

4.11. The reviews should be briefly evaluated:

- general scientific level of work;
- title and its correspondence to the content of the article;
- relevance of the topic;
- scientific novelty,
- practical significance of the presented conclusions;
- work structure;
- the presence of controversial and/or incorrect provisions in the work;
- the positive aspects or shortcomings of the article are noted, what corrections and additions should be made by the author;
- the reviewer's opinion on the possibility or impossibility of publishing the manuscript is stated.

The conclusion of the review is communicated to the author under the guidance of the responsible secretary.

4.12. An article sent to the author for revision must be returned in corrected form within 10 days with the corrections noted in the article. The editors reserve the right to reject articles if the author is unable or unwilling to take the editorial wishes into account. Original reviews are stored on the website of the journal "Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology."

Chapter 5. Manual for authors of manuscripts

5.1. The finished scientific work for publication in the journal "Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology" can be submitted by the author(s) through the online submission system of articles on the website vestnik.korkyt.kz using special instructions. The article must be written in Word format in Windows 10 in Times New Roman font (an article not written in

accordance with this requirement will not be accepted automatically). Language of publications: Kazakh, Russian, English.

5.2. By submitting the text of the work for publication in the journal, the author guarantees the correctness of all information about himself, the absence of plagiarism and other forms of illegal borrowing in the manuscript, the proper design of all borrowings of the text, tables, diagrams, illustrations. Authors should compose articles based on scientific discovery and practical value, as well as the principles of academic honesty, and observe the mutual harmony of words, combining modern fundamental and applied issues in the field of pedagogical and psychological sciences.

5.3. It is not allowed to use the text of other authors with synonymous substitution (plagiarism) translated from another language; use and (or) ownership of the text, ideas, hypotheses, conclusions, methods, research results, tables, codes, images and works without reference to other authors and the source of the use of the text, as well as words and opinions without modification, including with the use of text; refer to non-existent sources, do not present conflicting data and (or) results, records or notification on them.

5.4. The list of citations in the article should contain only peer-reviewed literature sources, information sources, available DOI index in accordance with the structure of the article. Theoretical scientific articles should include research results using methods such as abstraction, synthesis, analysis, induction, inference, formalization, idealization, modeling. The logical legislative and regulatory framework should prevail. Although a number of theoretical methods are used in scientific works of an empirical nature, they should rely more on measurement methods, observations, experiments used in psychological and pedagogical science. In addition, the article should include new scientific results, provisions, recommendations and conclusions. The totality should consist of new, scientifically based theoretical, research results in pedagogy and psychology, defined as a new scientific achievement or scientifically based solutions that contribute to the development of Kazakh science.

All sections and provisions of the article should have a logical connection; scientific provisions, results and recommendations should correspond to the goals and objectives of the article.

5.5. Structure and design of the article:

1. The volume of the article is from 6 to 12 pages (without a list of references and annotations).

2. The layout of the article (page - A 4, portrait orientation, margins on the left, top and bottom sides - 2.5 m, with parva - 2.0 mm. Font: type - Times New Roman, size (point size) - 12):

- MRNTI index - first line from top left <http://grnti.ru>

- DOI index (provided by the editors of the journal);

- The title of the article - in capital letters, center alignment in bold, size (size) -

12.

- Initials and surname of the author(s) - center alignment, size (point size) – 11, number of authors of the article should not exceed five people.

- Full name of the organization, city, country (if the authors work in different organizations, it is necessary to put the same number next to the name of the author and the corresponding organization, the authors' email address, orsid number) - center alignment, italics, size (point size) - 11.

- **Annotation** in the original language (150-200 words; keeping the structure of the article) size (point size) - 11.

- **Keywords** (in Kazakh, Russian, English from 5 to 8 words / phrases) size (point size) - 11.

- **Main text** (12 font, line spacing - 1, "red line" indent - 1.25 cm)

- structure:

3) **Introduction:** rationale for the choice of topic; the relevance of the topic or problem, the definition of the object, subject, goals, objectives, methods, approaches, hypotheses and meanings of the work.

4) **Materials and methods of research:** should consist of a description of the materials and the progress of the work, as well as a full description of the methods used. This section describes how the problem was studied: detailed information without repeating previously published established procedures; identification of equipment (software) and description of materials are used, with mandatory novelty when using materials and methods. Tables and figures should be placed after the mention.

5.6. Each illustration must be accompanied by a caption (size (font) – 11). Figures must be clear, clean, and not scanned. Figure and table titles are bold in 11-point font. Table indices are formatted in 11-point font. All abbreviations and acronyms, with the exception of those that are obviously well-known, must be expanded upon their first mention in the text. Only formulas referenced in the text are numbered in the article.

5.7. In the article, only those formulas referenced in the text are numbered. In the text, references are displayed in square brackets. References must be strictly numbered in the text. The first reference in the text must contain the number [1], the second - [2], etc. References to unpublished works are not allowed. References to non-peer-reviewed publications are undesirable.

5) results/discussion: an analysis and discussion of the results of the study is provided.

6) conclusion/conclusions: generalization and summing up of the work at this stage; confirmation of the truth of the statement put forward by the author. Conclusions should be used to summarize the results of research in a particular scientific field, with a description of proposals or opportunities for further work. Information about financial support for the work should be indicated at the end of the article.

7) list of references size (size) – 11, the number of literature used is at least 15). The list of references is presented in two versions: the first - in the original language, the second - in Latin transliteration (<https://translit.ru/>), in Latin letters. The list of

citations in the article should contain literature sources corresponding to the scientific direction of the article, with a DOI index (or URL) (sample appendix 2). The serial number of the literature is numbered in vertical brackets in accordance with the reference.

The style of the list of references in Russian and Kazakh is carried out in accordance with the requirements according to GOST P 7.1. – 2003 "Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and rules of compilation".

5.8. Information about the authors: (must contain the full name of the author(s), full name of the organization, city, country, contact details: phone, email, Orcid ID) in 3 languages. If the author does not have an Orcid ID, you must register with the Orcid ID at the link: <https://orcid.org/>.

5.9. If the articles submitted to the editorial office meet the requirements of the journal, an anti-plagiarism procedure will be carried out. An article whose originality exceeds 80% is sent to the editorial office for consideration, an article below 80% is sent to the author for correction, additions. (The cost of the first check of an article for originality in the Antiplagiat program is 2000 tenge, and a repeat check of the same article costs 1500 tenge). After a positive review by the reviewers, the article is accepted for publication in the journal and a payment notification is sent to the author. The author is obliged to send a payment receipt to the editorial office by e-mail (khabarshy@korkyt.kz).

5.10. The cost of the article: The cost of one article in the scientific direction of journal «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology» is 5000 tenge.

5.11. The editorial board of the journal provides 3 days for each author to review their articles before publishing the latest version of the PDF version on the website of the University «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology» <https://vestnik.korkyt.kz> and on the Crossref website <https://crossref.org/webDeposit/> The final version of the journal will be published on the website after accepting the authors' reviews, responses, etc. The authors' notifications are not accepted and the editorial board is not responsible for subsequent identified errors.

Chapter 6. Anti-Corruption Policy

6.1. The Editorial Board of the journal «Bulletin of the Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University. Pedagogy and Psychology» carries out its activities in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the principles of academic integrity, transparency, and objectivity.

6.2. The acceptance, peer review, and publication of scientific articles are carried out on the basis of the principle of equality, regardless of the authors' position, academic degree, place of work, or other circumstances.

6.3. Any form of corrupt practices is prohibited, including the acceptance or offering of remuneration, gifts, services, or other advantages in order to publish an article, alter peer review results, or expedite the editorial process.

6.4. Members of the editorial board and reviewers are obliged to observe the principles of independence and objectivity, as well as to promptly disclose any conflict of interest.

6.5. All materials undergo the established review and peer-review procedures. Decisions on publication are made solely on the basis of the scientific significance, relevance, and quality of the article.

6.6. Persons who violate the requirements of this Anti-Corruption Policy shall be held liable in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulatory documents of Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University.

Chapter 7. Final Provisions

7.1. These Regulations have been developed in the Kazakh and Russian languages. In the event of any discrepancies or contradictions between the Russian and Kazakh versions of this Personnel Policy, the Russian-language version shall prevail.

7.2. These Regulations shall be approved by the decision of the Management Board of Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University and shall enter into force by the order of the Chairman of the Management Board – Rector.

7.3. These Regulations constitute an internal regulatory document of the University. Exclusive intellectual property rights to this document belong to Korkyt Ata Kyzylorda University.

7.4. Full or partial use, reproduction and distribution of the document is allowed only with the indication of the source or with the written consent of the University, except in cases provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

7.5. Amendments and additions to these Regulations shall be introduced in accordance with the established procedure.

7.6. These Regulations have been prepared on 14 (fourteen) pages with Appendices № 1, 2, and 3.
